The changes are in many ways a consequence of the process of modernisation. This process had been occurring gradually in the city since the 1960s. But, after 2010, it accelerated, as more individuals were attracted by the new job opportunities that existed in Gwadar, and by the relaxation in entry requirements and the deployment of higher education facilities in the city. Local political stakeholders, as well as observers of Pakistani politics, believed that the change was a result of the policies and actions of the new chief executive of Balochistan, Mir Nawab Bugti (d.19 January 2011), and the policies of Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, who was at the time the governor of Punjab. The old city is set within the site of the 20th century's 'Great Bengal Famine'. This famine is likely to have been a significant factor in the flight of many local Muslims to East Pakistan. Approximately 1.7 million people left Quetta and southern Punjab for East Pakistan, of whom more than 300,000 remained in the city following the partition of the country in the first few months of December 1947. 82157476af
